English

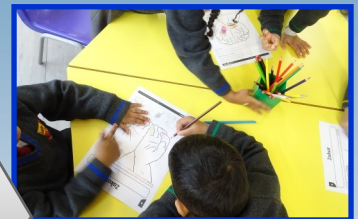

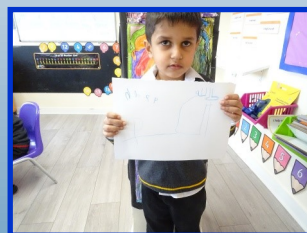
Qur'an and Islamic Studies
