How will my child be assessed this term?

Children will be assessed on their knowledge and understanding of the topics covered during the term.

How can I help my child in this subject?

English

Term: Spring

Teacher: Mr Zafar/ Mr Zeeshan

What will we be covering this term?

1st half term:

Grammar and Punctuation:

Pupils will be learning about proper nouns, suffixes ity, explanation texts, semi colons, colons, play script writing, complex sentences, fact/ opinion, root words, onomatopoeia, idioms, poetry rhythm and rhyme, homophones, homonyms, contractions.

Composition:

Pupils will be studying play scripts looking at genre features, conventions, write their own scripts and being able to continue scenes from films. In explanation texts pupils will be studying how to write in chronological order, being able to use technical language and being able to use all genre language.

Comprehension

They will learn to:

Discuss words and phrases of the writer

Provide justifications for their answers

Be able to infer from future chapters from English Literature texts.

Spelling

Pupils will be given 10 words for each week for the term to revise and will be tested with a dictation test

Literature

Animal Farm by George Orwell

2nd half term:

Grammar and Punctuation:

Formal and informal speech, using the dictionary, haiku poetry, fronted adverbials, expanding sentence form, passive sentences, using similes

Composition:

Pupils will be writing a book review being able to provide justifications for their opinions as well as being able to construct non chronological reports. They will be able to use sub headings, correct use of diagrams and illustrations as well as being able to write about events with details and technical language

Comprehension

They will learn to:

Discuss words and phrases of the writer and intended themes and moods

Provide justifications for their answers with evidence

Be able to infer from future chapters from the English Literature text.

Pupils will be given 10 words for each week for the term to revise and will be tested with a dictation test

Term: Spring

Teacher: Mr Zafar/ Mr Zeeshan

What will we be covering this term?

Pupils will be studying the text *Animal Farm* by George Orwell. A challenging text, pupils will be:

- Undertaking character analyses
- infer and deduce events from the narrative
- be able to make generalisations about chapters
- be able to create songs, anthems and creative pieces based on the themes and ideas of the story

How will my child be assessed this term?

Class observations and an end of unit project

How can I help my child in this subject?

Online cartoon is available to watch on youtube to help with a visualisation of the novel for pupils

Term: Spring

What will we be covering this term?

1st Half Term:

Pupils will be playing and developing their skills in hockey. Pupils will be learning how to work as part of a team as well as being able to use materials safely and how to think strategically.

2nd Half Term: pupils will be learning all about basketball including dribbling, passing, shooting, dexterity, rules of play as well as being able to work cohesively as part of a team and to think of team building tactics.

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Art

Term: Spring

What will we be covering this term?

1st Half Term:

Pupils will be learning about 'North American Art' unit. Pupils about how to draw the other half of a famous image, make collage landscapes, create body abstracts, make 'building block' houses, draw patterned skulls and be an artist's model to create quality artwork that shows progression in skills. The children will also have the opportunity to explore the work of American artists John Singer Sargent, Helen Frankenthaler, Jean-Michel Basquiat, Mary Cassatt, architect Frank Lloyd Wright and photographer Ansel Adams.

2nd Half Term:

Pupils will be learning about sketching, drawing and proportion. Pupils will be learning skills about great artists, architects and designers in history in the context of Man Ray; be creating Egyptian masks and studying paintings.

How will my child be assessed this term?

Class observations will take place

How can I help my child in this subject?

Taking an interest in Islamic architecture such as Alhambra palace, geometric designs and arabesque constructions will help to develop your child's passion for the topics covered.

Term: Spring

What will we be covering this term?

Pupils will be learning about Judaism this term. They will be learning about practices such as Hanukah, the Bar mitzvah, synagogues, the Torah scrolls as well as looking at historical perspectives of Judaism as well comparisons with other religions of the world.

How will my child be assessed this term?

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Science

Term: Spring

Teacher: Mr Zafar/ Mr Zeeshan

What will we be covering this term?

1st Half Term: Pupils will be learning about Animals including humans and will be learning about: Children will learn about the life cycle of a human being. They will investigate the development of babies and compare the gestation period of humans and other animals. They will learn about the changes experienced during puberty and why these occur. The final investigation will be about the changes to the body as humans get older, as well as comparing the life expectancy of different animals.

2nd Half Term: Pupils will be learning about Living Things and Their Habitats and will be learning about: † the process of reproduction and the life cycles of plants, mammals, amphibians, insects and birds. The children will explore reproduction in different plants, including different methods of pollination and asexual reproduction. They will learn about different types of mammals and their different life cycles, making life cycle wheels to present their learning. Furthermore, the children will find out about Jane Goodall and her work with the now-endangered chimpanzees in Africa. They will explore metamorphosis in insects and amphibians, comparing their life cycles. Finally, the children will explore the life cycles of birds, and will write and star in their own wildlife documentary comparing the life cycles of different living things.

Term: Spring

What will we be covering this term?

1st Half Term: Pupils will be learning about Excel and will be learning how to: use cells, rows, columns, what is a formula and how to input it, how to use calculations for tables, charts and graphs as well as being able to use data inputted into a table.

2nd Half Term: Pupils will be learning how to use Microsoft Word and Paint. Pupils will learn how to manipulate images, crop and add effects, how to paragraph, label and annotate writing, how to insert and embed links in documents as well as being able to apply these skills in real life work skills,

Pupils will be learning about the influences of Muslim from the past and the Golden Age in the 1001 inventions unit. Pupils will be learning about:

Muslim Spain;

influences of scientists such as Ibn Sina and Al Kharizmi;

modern invention in science, medicine and astronomy;

role of Muslim women in facilitating European advancement;

application of the Sunnah in the modern world.

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Maths

Term: Spring

Teacher: Mr Zafar/ Mr Zeeshan

What will we be covering this term?

1st half term: Pupils will be learning about decimals, rounding up to three places, problems involving decimals, add and subtract, measurement and money calculations, puzzles and word problems. Fractions will involve looking at proportions and amounts, compare / order fractions, add and subtract, probabilities, multiples and mixed numbers to improper fractions.

2nd half term: Pupils will be learning about percentages of amounts, comparing to fractions, finding equivalents, finding percentages of amounts. Area and perimeter of shapes in millimetres, symmetry of 2d shapes, reviewing place value, multiplication and division as well as preparing for the end of term exam through revision of the term's topics.

How will my child be assessed this term?

End of topic quizzes will be taking place
