Y3A enjoyed making colourful clocks to help them practise how to tell the time. They used paper plates and split pins to create these wonderful educational pieces.




### Year 6 Croydon Citizenship Award




# Spring Half Term 'Shakespeare Competition' Winners

#### From Rajab to Ramadan

Rajab is here and Ramadan is just around the corner! Do you want to make the most out of this opportunity? Then, get ready and plan! Prepare your hearts for the imaan recharging journey in the month of Ramadan. Rajab is one of the four sacred months. Although there is no particular act of worship prescribed in the Sunnah for the month of Rajab, the salaf used to increase in their ibadah and recitation of Quran.

How can we honour the month of Rajab and use it as a preparation for Ramadan?

#### **Reflect on your Deeds:**

Take some alone time and ask yourself the hard questions we normally don't like: Have I been conscious of what I am saying and doing to those around me?

#### Fasting:

There is no better way to prepare for Ramadan than to fast some extra days. While we can't escape having Ramadan in the summer, we can do something valuable before we are all obligated to fast. Now is the time to prepare for fasting and gain some reward as the temperature rises.

#### **Charity:**

Most of us do some act of charity every day without realizing it. In this sacred month, be charitable with the intention of pleasing Allah (swt). Being courteous, helping someone, saying a good word and even abstaining from doing a bad deed are all non-monetary forms of charity taught to us by the Messenger (saww).

#### Supplicate (make dua) to Allah:

Ask Allah (swt) to make the month of Rajab, and the following month of Sha'ban, a means for us to prepare for Ramadan. It is reported that the Prophet of Allah used to supplicate when Rajab came, "O Allah! Bless us during Rajab and Sha'ban, and let us reach Ramadan."

### Recommended Supplications During Rajab

أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللهَ لِما يَعْلَمُهُ الله أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللهَ كَما يُحِبُّهُ الله

Astaghfirullāh limā ya`lamuhu Allāh, Astaghfirullāh
