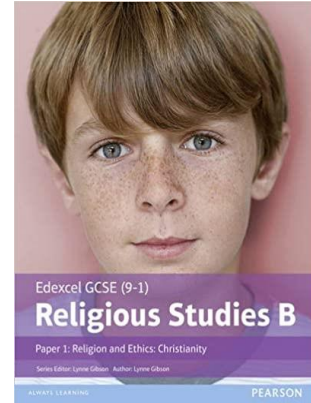

What will we be covering this term?

1st Half Term: In the first half-term we will be learning about Christian Beliefs, students will learn about Christian perspectives on:

- the nature of God
- the incarnation of Jesus and their roles within the trinity
- the creation of the universe and humanity
- salvation, atonement and the problem of evil and suffering
- life after death and Christian eschatology

2nd Half Term: Once students are familiar with the fundamental beliefs in Christianity, we will be looking at the topic; Living the Christian Life, this will help students understand the different practices such as:

- Worship
- The sacraments
- Prayer
- Pilgrimage
- Christian celebrations
- The local church
- The worldwide church and its future

There will be an end of term exam based on what students have covered this half-term.

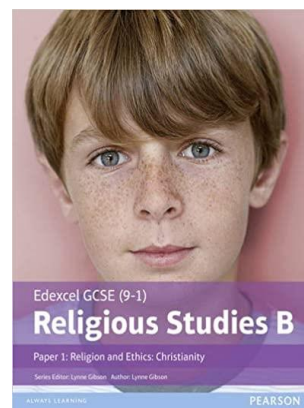

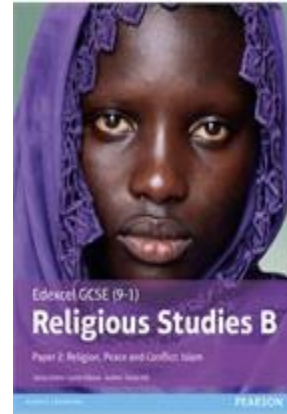

What will we be covering this term?

1st Half Term: In the first half-term we will be learning about Muslim Beliefs, students will learn about Muslim perspectives on:

- The Six beliefs of Islam
- The five roots of Usul-ad-Din in Shi'a Islam
- The nature of Allah
- Risalah- prophethood
- Muslim holy books
- Malaikah: angels
- Al-Qadr: predestination
- Akhirah: life after death

2nd Half Term: Once students are familiar with the fundamental beliefs in Islam, we will be looking at the topic; Living the Muslim Life, this will help students understand the different practices such as:

- Ten obligatory acts of Shi'a Islam
- Shahadah as one of the five pillars
- Sawm as one of the five pillars
- Zakah as one of the Five pillars and Khums
- Hajj as one of the five pillars
- Jihad
- Celebrations and commemorations
