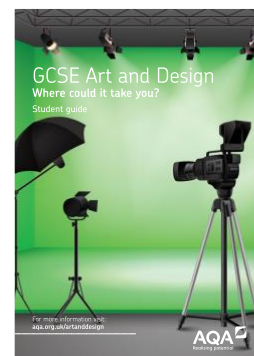

What will we be covering this term?

Art & Design: Art, Craft & Design

During this term, pupils will continue KS4 Art, Craft & Design GCSE in Year 11. They will be working on their Graphic Communication Project on the Olympics and starting their project on Islamic Art simultaneously for Component 1 (Portfolio)

How will my child be assessed this term?

Art & Design is the only GCSE offered at Al-Khair which is **100% non-exam** assessment comprising of 2 components.

This Term will focus on Component 1: Students are required to submit a portfolio (collection of students work comprising of classwork and homework) that comprises a sustained project and a selection of further work which represents their course of study.

Student progress is monitored continuously through a variety of testing methods, including, class work, homework and summative assessment.



The skills are assessed according to 4 set Assessment Objectives (AO) which each carry the same weight in terms of marking:

- **AO1 - Develop** ideas through investigations, demonstrating critical understanding of sources.
- **AO2 - Refine** work by exploring ideas, selecting and experimenting with appropriate media, materials, techniques and processes.
- **AO3 - Record** ideas, observations and insights relevant to intentions as work progresses.
- **AO4 - Present** a personal and meaningful response that realises intentions and demonstrates understanding of visual language.

All assessment marks are recorded in SIMS and on a tracker in students' books.

How can I help my child in this subject?

Your child's approach to this subject has to be completely different to any other subject at Al-Khair. The course is **100% non-exam** assessment, so your child has to focus on classwork and homework to achieve a higher grade.

It is recommended that each pupil develops their own glossary (vocabulary primarily associated with their Art syllabus).

Encourage your child to **plan** and **prepare** for their lessons and to be proactive in seeking advice from their teacher.

Please ensure that your child is up to date with their homework. Any missed homework would be flagged in your child's diary.

I would encourage you to take your child on trips to galleries, museums or places of interest and to record their visits.

How will my child be assessed this term?

Students are select a theme from a list and work from start to finish on this theme for the duration of the term.

They will be assessed via timed 10 hour examination which will be arranged with the students and will involve work during out of school hours.

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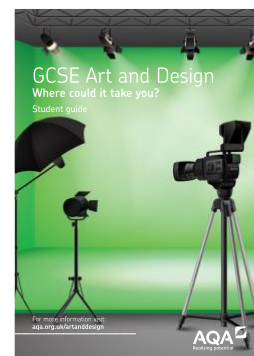
