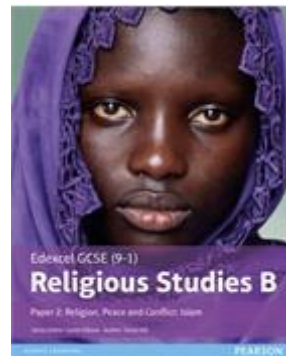

**What will we be covering this term?**

**1<sup>st</sup> Half Term:** In the first half-term we will be covering the topic, Living the Muslim Life. In this topic students will find out about:

- Shahada, the first pillar of Islam
- Salah, the second pillar of Islam
- Sawm, the third pillar of Islam
- Zakah, the fourth pillar of Islam
- Hajj, the fifth pillar of Islam
- Jihad
- Islamic festivals and celebrations

**2<sup>nd</sup> Half Term:** In the second half term we will move onto Chapter 3 Crime and Punishment, in this topic will look at:

- Crime & Justice
- Action to end the causes of crime
- Good, evil & suffering
- Punishment
- Aims of punishment
- Forgiveness
- The treatment of criminals
- Capital punishment

There will be an end of term exam based on what students have covered in each half-term.

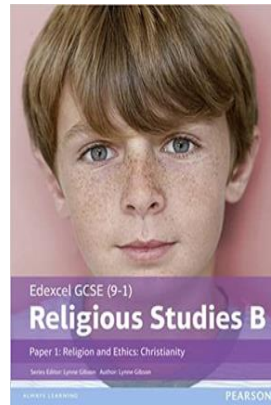

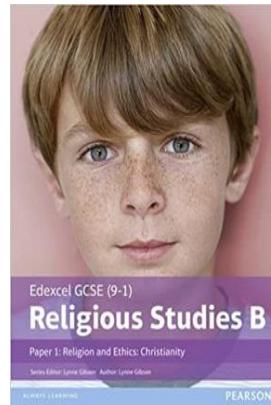
