What will we be covering this term?

Half term 1

Teamwork and Diversity

This unit will give a chance for students to work together to design a social enterprise app as part of a project with Amazon Web Services. The students will be looking at what makes a good team and why diversity is important to make a team successful. The students will have opportunities to work in a mixed gender group.

Half Term 2

Drugs Education
