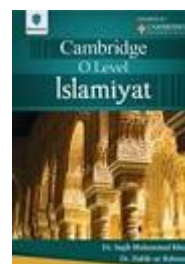

What will we be covering this term?

1st Half Term:

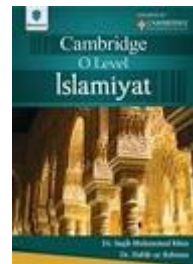

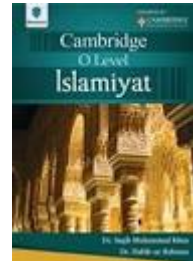
