What will we be covering this term?

1st Half Term:

In this half-term we will begin to study World War One. Students will focus on the impact World War One had on key European countries. The causes and consequences of the First World War will be examined, and students will have the opportunity to examine a wide range of historical sources. Students will also examine the experiences of soldiers and focus on battles such as the Battle of Somme.

2nd Half Term:

Students will begin studying Weimar and Nazi Germany 1918-39 Unit.

- Weimar Germany after War
- The Recovery of the Weimar Republic
- The early development of the Nazi Party
- The Munich Putsch

There will be an end of term exam based on what students have covered this half-term.

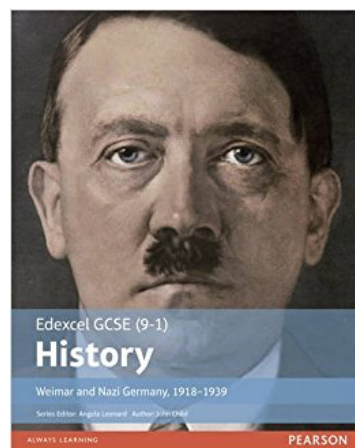

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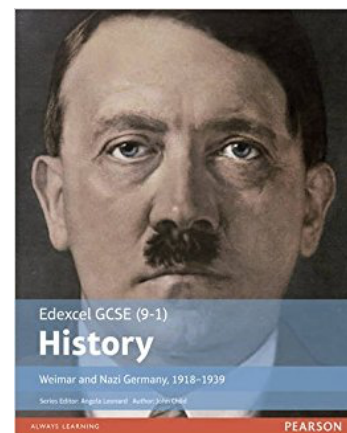
