HISTORY OVERVIEW

What will we be covering this term?

1st Half Term - Victorians

Children will research and learn about the Victorian Era. Who reigned at that time? How did the Victorian period differ in relation to other periods of British history? What was life like for Victorian children compared to children in modern times? How was Victorian schooling different? These are just some of the questions that children will be able to answer following their study of this Era.

2nd Half Term - The Crimean War

Children will be able to explain the Crimean War and how life was impacted by this. They will also look at what medical processes were used for soldiers in the War.

Florence Nightingale (1820-1910)

One of the many influential figures in history - how did she become famously known as 'The Lady with the Lamp'? and what impact did her lifetime contribution have on modern nursing? Throughout this half term, children will creatively, gain a broader understanding of Florence Nightingale by researching, making posters and role play.

How will my child be assessed this term?

During the term there will be ongoing progress checks of classwork in order to provide a formative assessment of your child's progress throughout the year.
